A national member federation is eligible to submit candidates for FIBA Licenses, based on the principles and requirements set out in the FIBA Internal Regulations and the FIBA Game Officials Licensing 2023-2025 - Guidelines for national member federations.

The License Allocations' Number does not automatically guarantee a national member federation a maximum number of approved Licenses.

The License Allocations' Number gives a national member federation a right to apply for the designated number of Allocations. However, in each case, after a thorough analysis, FIBA will decide on the final number and categories of Licenses per national member federation.

In case the same referee from the same national member federation is nominated for more than one FIBA National Team Competition it is only counted as 1 License Allocation (e.g. 1 referee from one national member federation in the Olympic Qualifying Tournament and the FIBA U19 World Championship).

A License Allocation is granted when a nominated referee fully participates in the preparation programme of the respective Competition and successfully passes all the tests related to the preparation for the Competition.
